Tests your ability to interpret science experiments

Four passages-prose fiction,
Social Science, Humanities, \& Natural Sciences

Only correct answers are counted-no penalty for guessing

1-36 for each of the four tests
Averaged for a composite score Top score is 36

Measures how you apply what you learned in school.

128 multiple choice questions, 10 fill ins, and essay

Fundamentals through $10^{\text {th }}$ grade math, including geometry, some statistics and probability \& data analysis (33-50\% of your score)

The first 25 minute of the test

No science questions

Sentence completions, short and long critical reading passages, reading comprehension

Yes $1 / 4$ of a point for each wrong answer deducted

200-800 for each section Combined together for score Top score is 2400 -all 3 parts
