This message is to inform you that we have some changes with our course textbooks this year. For example, FBISD has given each Science teacher a class set of books to use within his/her classroom. The students will be allowed to use these books within the classroom on a daily basis. The Science teachers have provided their students with an online access code that will allow them to do their assignments, study quizzes and tests, and use as a reference. Students will be able to study at home, in the EHS library, or within their Science classroom using their access code. Currently, the textbooks that being issued from the EHS bookroom are as follows:

- Math (All Subjects)
- Science (Chemistry AP and Physics C)
- Social Studies (World Geography, World History, U.S. History, U.S. History AP, American Government, Economics, Economics AP, Psychology AP, Human Geography AP, European History AP)
- English (Teachers in English I, II, III, and IV have a class set of books for both English Literature and Writing. Paperback novels are issued to the students throughout the school year by their English teacher.)
- World Languages (Spanish I, II, III, IV, V and French I, II, and III)
- Electives (The majority of the elective teachers currently have a class set of textbooks within their classroom. Either supplemental materials are given to the student, or they have access to computers within their elective class to use and get assignments completed.)

Students have been asking their parents to fill out a Textbook Request Form. This form is used to help the students request a hard copy textbook that they will need for a course they are taking. It must be signed by the student and their parent, and it must be dated. The students can bring their completed Textbook Form to the EHS bookroom each school day from 7:00 A.M. – 8:15 A.M.
