Dear Parent or Guardian:

One of the biggest concerns for many parents is wondering how medical expenses would be paid if their child was involved in an accident. Injuries can happen anywhere, at any time.

In the past, Fort Bend ISD has purchased a blanket accident only policy to assist with this. **That coverage will not be provided this year.**

However, the District is making an affordable accident only plan available to your child through a Voluntary Student Accident Program. This program gives parents the opportunity to purchase Accident Only Insurance that is effective on the day after enrollment premium has been received by the company and terminates in one year from effective date. There are three (3) programs from which you can choose. One is an At-School accident only insurance program; another is a 24-Hour accident only insurance program and a Varsity Football (Grades 10-12 Fall & Spring)accident only voluntary policy.

If the injury is a covered accident, this Voluntary Accident Insurance Program will supplement any other personal insurance which you may have.

The voluntary Accident Insurance Program works with the TKF Provider Network, the largest no-balance billing network in the state. This means that the doctors and facilities on the network may accept full assignment for covered benefits under this plan. You can search for doctors and facilities on this network by visiting the Texas Kids First website at www.TexasKidsFirst.com and clicking on the Provider Directory Search.

You will find the Voluntary Accident Insurance costs and plan benefits in the enrollment Form. To enroll your child, you may request an Enrollment Brochure from the Coach or Athletic Trainer or the school office, go online to enroll by using the web site www.TexasKidsFirst.com, or you may call 800-366-8354 for an application.
