**What is the Spend the Day with the Corps Program?**

The Spend the Day with the Corps (SDWC) program is an official campus visit to Texas A&M University offered each summer for rising high school juniors and seniors as well as their parents. SDWC provides an outstanding opportunity to gain invaluable information about the University and the Corps of Cadets. Activities throughout the day include a university admissions application workshop, presentations from various departments around campus including scholarships and financial aid, involvement with Cadets, Staff and ROTC representatives, and tours. During check-in, prospective students and families will be able to visit the many resource tables representing A&M's different college departments, organizations, and college preparatory agencies. This fun and informative day will end with a "Fightin Texas Aggie" Yell Practice.

**When is SDWC Offered?**

SDWC is offered twice each summer. For specific dates, go to [www.aggiecorps.org](http://www.aggiecorps.org) and click on Spend the Day with the Corps on the blue navigation bar.

**How Do I Register?**

SDWC requires pre-registration. To reserve your space for the program, you must register online at [www.aggiecorps.org](http://www.aggiecorps.org). Once registered, you will return the SDWC Camp & Enrichment Liability Waiver form along with the \$25 non-refundable registration fee to the Corps Recruiting Office. *Students will not be allowed to participate without a confirmed registration, completed Camp & Enrichment Liability Waiver form and the \$25 registration fee.*

**How Do I Prepare for SDWC?**

When we receive your registration form and fee, we will mail your SDWC Confirmation Packet to you. Please review your packet! Before attending SDWC, we strongly recommend that all seniors prepare an initial draft of Part II of the application (Activities) and initial drafts of Essay Topics "A", "B" and "C".
